Katoh Gakuen Gyoshu High School is a private Japanese school founded in 1982 as a university preparatory school. We became the first school in Japan to be both accredited by Japan's Ministry of Education and by International Baccalaureate (IB)-- offering the Middle Years Programme (MYP) from 2000 and the Diploma Programme (DP) from 2002. Our grade 7-9 students take half of their classes in English and the other half in Japanese. Grade 10-12 students take classes in English, except Japanese Language A Literature and Mandarin *ab initio*. All of our instructors are certified high school teachers who come from a range of countries. Our students go on to study either here in Japan or abroad.

## Courses

All Bilingual students study the same MYP curriculum in grade 10. Generally, in grades 11 and 12, Bilingual students study three higher level (HL) and three standard level (SL) IBDP courses in addition to Theory of Knowledge (TOK) and Physical Education. All students complete an IBDP 4000-word Extended Essay, a TOK essay, and CAS (creativity-activity-service). Students choose from the following IBDP courses.
